

Non-native Species Alert

New Zealand Pigmyweed

AKA **Australian Swamp-stonecrop**

Crassula helmsii



Forms dense mats in still or slow flowing water bodies, and on damp margins.

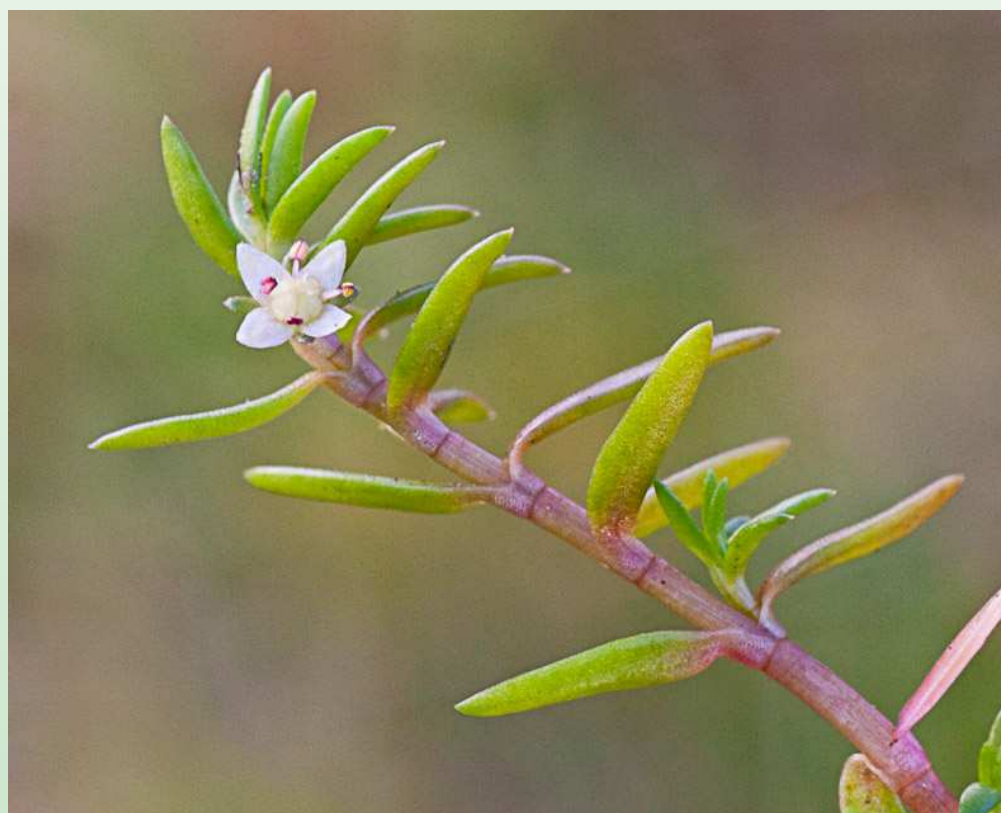
Identification features:

Stem: round and fleshy

Leaves: up to 2cm long in opposite pairs.

Flowers: very small or absent, white, 4 petals .

Originally introduced as an oxygenating plant for ponds, it has spread into the wider environment. It displaces other native aquatic plant species, forming dense mats, which can impede drainage and cause flooding.
